

## Indoor Soccer League Playoff Rules

1. There are NO GUEST players allowed in the playoffs. (If a team is short players they may borrow players from the opposing team so the game can be played, but the game is still a forfeit).

**Minimum number of players to start and continue to play is 5 players. If a team is unable to meet the minimum number of players, it must forfeit the game.**

3. A player may play on more than one team in a division. However, he or she must be registered on each team he or she plays on.

**\*\*Player registered in TWO teams under the same division, he/she must pick which team he/she will play for during playoffs. HE/SHE WILL NOT BE ALLOWED TO PLAY FOR TWO TEAMS DURING PLAYOFFS – NO EXCEPTIONS!**

4. There must be an adult on the bench at all times. He or she will accept full responsibility for the team's actions. If no responsible adult is present, the game will result in a forfeit.

**5. ONLY PARTICIPATING PLAYERS & TWO ADULT COACHES ARE ALLOWED IN THE BENCH AREAS DURING GAME.**

**\* Championship games will be 20 minutes halves with a 3 minute half time. In the event of a tie teams will play one (5) min. sudden death overtime period. A tied game can also be defined with a shootout game. Each team will choose 3 players for the shootout. Shootout rules are applied**

**NOTE: ABSOLUTELY NO FIGHTING OR CURSING WILL BE TOLERATED! All parties involved in a dispute may be ejected from the game, league and/or facility at the discretion of the referee and facility.**

**The referee can STOP the game at any time.**

**REFEREE CALLS ARE FINAL**

**\*Any rule can be changed and/or altered at the discretion of the management.**
